

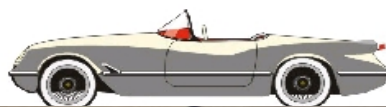



Purpose of St. Louis Corvette Club:


Ann Brown won \$85.00 in the 50-50 raffle.

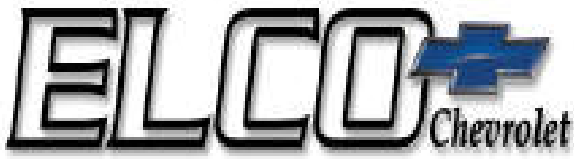
